Financial Policies

- 1. Checks:** Please make checks payable to Arlington Faith Academy or AFA. Return checks will be assessed a \$25 return check fee. Be sure to include the child's name in the memo and write your Drivers License Number on the checks. After three (3) non-sufficient checks, only cashier's checks, money orders, or cash will be accepted. The bookkeeping office will not hold checks. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- 2. Cash:** You must get a receipt from the AFA office to ensure proper credit for cash payments.
- 3. Late Payments:** Payments are due on the 1st of the month and are considered late after 5:00 p.m. on the 6th of the month. (Note: the grace period will be extended to the next business day when the 6th falls on the weekend.) A \$20 late fee will be charged to your account for payments made after the 6th. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 4. Statements:** To save on mailing and processing costs, monthly statements will only be sent if the account has an overdue balance.
- 5. Dis-enrollment:** If a student's tuition becomes past due one (1) month, and satisfactory arrangements have not been made, the student(s) will not be admitted to class until both the past due and currently due payments are made.
- 6. Report Cards, Student Records, and RenWeb Access** will be withheld from students who at the end of the grading period (including the end of the school year) have a past due balance for tuition or any other fees.
- 7. Damaged Property:** Assessments will be made to cover damage by any student of school property including windows, desks, books, etc.
- 8. Withdrawals:** Enrollment is intended to be for the entire school year.
 - All application/enrollment, book fees, and testing fees are Non-Refundable.
 - Parents will be expected to pay for any time less than one month's notice.
 - Exception—If the student leaves at the request of the school administration, the balance/refund will be determined on an individual basis depending on the payment plan selected.

The Arlington Faith Academy is grateful for the opportunity to serve the communities of Arlington, Kennedale, Mansfield, and the surrounding areas.

The greatest gift a parent can give a child is a Christian education. Arlington Faith Academy is solely dedicated to providing the Christian family with a Christ centered, Biblically directed education, which instills the vision and practices of excellence in academic, character training, and servitude to God and man.

Information about our school:

1. The academy is enrolling students for kindergarten through eighth grade.
2. ABEKA curriculum is the core curriculum.
3. Emphasis is on the Christian character development through a Christ-centered philosophy.
4. School hours are 8:15 a.m. to 3 p.m. (doors open at 7:50 a.m., students will be counted tardy after 8:15 a.m.)
5. Tuition is \$3700. Please see the enclosed payment schedule for complete details.
6. In order to hold a place for your child(ren), a non-refundable registration fee of \$100 per child is due at the time of acceptance into the school or no later than May 1. (This policy is under **Admission Procedure** in the Handbook.)
7. Book fees are due May 1. If admittance into the school is after May 1, all book fees are due at the time of registration. They are as follows: K5-2nd grades—\$300, 3rd-6th grades—\$350, and 7th-12th grades—\$400.
8. Uniforms are worn Monday through Friday. (Khaki or blue colored jeans, corduroy, or carpenter pants are not acceptable as school uniform. For children who dress inappropriately in non-dress code clothing, their parents will be called to bring proper dress.) Free dress Fridays will begin on September 14th.
9. We are members in good standing with the Association of Christian Schools International and have been for 20 years.
10. Arlington Faith Academy is accredited through ABeka Academy based in Pensacola, Florida.

It is our goal that your child is academically challenged while developing character traits enabling them to live and walk as a young Christian.
